From Fr. Vasek

Greetings,

When I arrived at St. Bernard's last year, the Lord drew me to the Gospel of Mark, chapter 6 - the feeding of the five thousand. I spent much time pondering the selection and drew much counsel and vision from it.

Marking one year here, the Lord drew me back to it again. It reminded me of many things and revealed new insights. The prayerful reading of Sacred Scripture never ceases to be a fountain of grace for the Christian life, and of supreme blessing in my own life.

Last year, I zeroed in on 6:34, where the words about showing compassion and teaching many things were lifted up for me. This year, 6:31-32 have been lifted up for me, where there are themes of fruitful labor and the need for rest.

I am honored to be the pastor here at St. Bernard's. I have felt both the dignity and the responsibility of the office this past year, and I am asking the Lord to give me the grace to fulfill my responsibilities among you with the same sentiments which are in the heart of the Good Shepherd, Jesus.

This week I will mark my anniversary of priestly ordination (2010). Priests renew their diaconal and priestly promises with the Bishop at the Chrism Mass each year. My priest-friend group all had those promises printed and framed, and they hang in my office, so I will renew my promises privately this week.
