From Fr. Vasek

Greetings,

On Saturday, May 25th, Bishop Cozzens will preside over the dedication of the new altar for the sanctuary. If you usually go to Sunday morning Mass, please try to come to Saturday evening's Mass to be present for this honorable moment with our Bishop. Our current altar will become the altar in the new adoration chapel. This move has to do with the size of the altars - the current altar is quite small and will fit well in the adoration chapel, and the sanctuary of the main church will benefit from a larger altar. Since we will soon have an expanded adoration chapel in the new construction, we no longer need an adoration chapel in the current church. The tabernacle will be moved from the tabernacle room into the center of the sanctuary. We will also place the beautiful statues of Jesus and Mary in the sanctuary, and the Crucifix will be hung above the tabernacle. As mentioned before, these items were discussed with the Pastoral Council and the Diocesan Liturgical Commission of the Bishop, were approved and welcomed warmly.

I pray that the Holy Spirit will come down and illumine our minds and bring a flame of divine love to our hearts at this time of Pentecost. I especially pray for the graduates of the parish as they embark upon the next chapter of their lives in Christ - congratulations!

I'm delighted that we can finally welcome our new hires for the expanding middle school. We had excellent candidates apply and it was a tough decision. Welcome, Macie, Tyler, and Carolyn!

Request a Mass Intention

The customary offering for a Mass intention is \$10. Intentions can be placed in the offertory or sent to the parish office. Indicate deceased individuals with a "+" before their name. Masses are scheduled in the order they are received, however, we will try to honor requested dates when possible. Canon law requires parishes to fulfill intentions within 1 year of receipt and may be fulfilled at either public or private Masses. Intentions that are unable to be fulfilled within 1 year are sent to the diocese to be fulfilled by other priests and parishes.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

There are 2 Changes to the Mass Schedule. Thursday is the last day of school, and the Mass will be a school Mass. It will start at 8:30 AM. On Friday, the summer Mass schedule will go into effect. Friday Masses will be at 8 AM from now until the resumption of school in the Fall.

The Dedication of the New Altar will take place at the Saturday, May 25, weekend Mass. Bishop Cozzens will preside over the dedication and consecration our new altar. Altar dedications usually only happen once-in-a-lifetime, so all are encouraged to attend this special Mass.

The Tabernacle and Crucifix in the Sanctuary will be moved later this week in anticipation of the installation and dedication of the altar. We apologize in advance for any disruptions this will cause for silence and prayer in the Church.

The Parish Office will be closed on Monday, May 27 for Memorial Day and on Tuesday, May 28 for a joint retreat of the parish staff and the Pastoral Council.

The Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession will take place on Sunday, June 2 immediately following the 9 AM Mass. The procession will leave from the sanctuary and travel around the block before returning to the altar for benediction. After the procession there will be fellowship and a potluck brunch in the parish hall. Please bring a dish to share!
