From Fr. Vasek

Greetings,

This coming weekend is the Diocesan Eucharistic Congress in Bemidji. I'm grateful to Father Rick for celebrating the weekend Masses here so that I can be present there in Bemidji with the 4000+ people from around the state. I hope you can be there, too.

During the week, I will be on my last leg of preaching / speaking travel for the season. I thank everyone who has filled in while I've been gone and I thank everyone for their patience as I've needed to juggle many responsibilities over the past month for the National Eucharistic Revival, the Diocese of Crookston, and the parish.

We've finalized plans for the May 25th installation and blessing of the new altar. Through consultation with a liturgical architect, the Building and Grounds committee, and the Pastoral Council, we've finalized the placement of the tabernacle in the center of the sanctuary, the hanging of the Crucifix from the ceiling a few feet away from the wall, and the setting of our principal statues towards the sides of the sanctuary. Bishop Cozzens was delighted to have these items in place prior to his arrival toward the end of the month. I was grateful for the help of Melissa Shanks, a liturgical architect, to help us organize the layout so that it complements the architecture of the church with the placement of these items. The height and depth of the hanging of the Crucifix was the most particular, and she gave good counsel on the pros and cons of a few different options. These items will be placed on the 23rd-25th of May prior to the 5PM evening Mass celebrated by Bishop Cozzens. I hope many people choose to come to the Saturday Mass that weekend, even if Sunday morning is your regularly attended Mass.

Request a Mass Intention

The customary offering for a Mass intention is \$10. Intentions can be placed in the offertory or sent to the parish office. Indicate deceased individuals with a "+" before their name. Masses are scheduled in the order they are received, however, we will try to honor requested dates when possible. Canon law requires parishes to fulfill intentions within 1 year of receipt and may be fulfilled at either public or private Masses. Intentions that are unable to be fulfilled within 1 year are sent to the diocese to be fulfilled by other priests and parishes.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

The 2024 Rectory Project is now accepting donations through ParishSOFT. St. Bernard's has a goal of raising \$220,000 for the purchase and remodel of 121 Duluth Ave North to be our new rectory as the building project continues. There is a further goal of raising an additional \$220,000 (for a total of \$440,000) to endow operating expenses. We have raised \$147,000 so far through the generosity of parishioners and donors. Dedication of the New Altar will take place at the Saturday, May 25, weekend Mass. Bishop Cozzens will preside over dedication and consecration our new altar. Altar dedications usually only happen once-in-a-lifetime, so all are encouraged to attend this special Mass.

The Corpus Christi Eucharistic Procession will take place on Sunday, June 2 immediately following the 9 AM Mass. The procession will leave from the sanctuary and travel around the block before returning to the altar for benediction. After the procession there will be fellowship and a potluck brunch in the parish hall. Please bring a dish to share!
