## From Fr. Vasek

Greetings,

This week will mark the end of my first year at St. Bernard's. It has been a really big whirlwind! Inheriting a building project, a parish recovering from the various impacts of the COVID-19 years, getting to know an entirely new staff, parishioner base, town and culture, all has been a lot. I know that this year has been a lot for many of you as well. I have heard many times of either the joys or frustrations of the many changes which have occurred. I know that change can be refreshing or troubling, and almost always is hard either way. To those who have been upset, or hurt, or have felt tension or sadness due to changes, I am sorry for any unnecessary troubles I have caused through my lack of care, attentiveness, or concern.

Please know that I have not been making changes simply for the sake of making changes. I pray, I discern, I appraise the various methods and ways of conducting life, and then make the changes that seem to serve the mission entrusted to me as Pastor. As you know, I speak regularly about how St. Bernard's is not only a parish of 500-700 people, or 700 families, but that 13,658 people belong to this parish. If we are going to be a parish at the service of the entire area which the Diocese has apportioned to this parish's care, we need to be organized to be outward-focused. Other changes were made to align with modern business policy, or in response to the bishops of the USA regarding care for the Most Blessed Sacrament and our worship together. And in other ways, since of course not all priests are robotic clones, each priest is just different than another priest.

As I begin a second year here, I'd like to state again what I stated when I first arrived – I would like to join you for dinner sometime throughout the year. Please invite me to your house or out to eat! This is not because I can't cook for myself – I want to get to know you all. Usually, a priest spends his first year getting to know parishioners – since I was given an assignment in the midst of many considerations, I needed to spend the first year getting directly to business. So, during my second year, I would very much enjoy spending time with families. As the nation celebrates its independence, please know of my prayer for you, that we would know the freedom of the republic, and the freedom found in the Savior.

Intentions that are unable to be fulfilled within 1 year are sent to the diocese to be fulfilled by other priests and parishes.
