Greetings,

EXALT

We had our first Exalt of the year this past Wednesday. Exalt is a monthly youth-focused event which hopes to foster a personal encounter with Jesus, an encounter which draws a person into a committed, daily relationship with Jesus as Savior and friend. There is contemporary music, adoration, confession, prayer ministry, prayer intention candles, guided prayer, small group fellowship, pizza, activities, and more. At the center of it, the hope is that people begin to choose Jesus for themselves, in freedom and joy. The long vision of Exalt is that it becomes a place for other Catholic youth of the region to join in, other non-Catholic youth of the city to join in, and people from all over the city to join in to encounter Jesus. Not everyone is ready for Mass, and Exalt might very well be a great place to "Invite 1" from your network of friends. I know that there are youth who have gifts in band and choir who would be great additions to the Exalt band. Be encouraged to join in! Thanks to Misty and Margaret for their coordination, and Becca and Pat for their music ministry.

MUSIC

Many music ministries are growing at St. Bernard's. The adult mixed choir sings twice a month. The younger youth and older youth choirs alternate once every month. There is a traveling youth choir forming and there has been an initial meeting for a men's small group choir. As mentioned above, the Exalt contemporary ministry can grow. 
