### From Fr. Vasek

Greetings,

May 17-18 is the Diocesan Eucharistic Congress in will Bemidji. There be national quality programming less than two hours away in; I'm going to be there - I hope you will be, too! Even if you can't get to Bemidji for the Congress itself, the launch of the National Eucharistic Pilgrimage begins with Holy Mass with Bishop Cozzens on May 19th at the headwaters of the Mississippi River in Itasca State Park. The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will end up being the longest Eucharistic Procession in the history of humanity wouldn't you like to say you were there? More info this event can be found on crookstoneucharist.org.

We've raised \$150K to acquire the 'old convent' to serve as the next rectory of St. Bernard's. The timing, location, and price of the property are all signs of God's blessing. While \$150K is the purchase price, we know that we need to make some capital improvements so that the house is rectory ready. Having studied the needs, we estimate \$50-75K of moving and move-in costs (exterior painting, adding a bathroom to the main level for guest use, HVAC updates, and furnishing). We anticipate some of those costs to be lessened by in-kind work or donations, as well as parish volunteerism. We should close on the house toward the end of the month of May.
